
- **“Snow Flurry”** Snowflakes in abundance! Could be worked in Silver or Gold on white – I chose to stitch in Mother of Pearl on a Jade card.
Pricking - 25 minutes, Stitching - approx. 2 hours.
- How about a **“Birthday Bonnet”**? - Quick & Easy to do. I worked it in Black/Rainbow ‘Glitz’ – pretty and sweet for someone pretty and sweet!
Pricking - 7 minutes, Stitching - approx. 45 minutes.
- **“Senior Moments”** Matching the Anniversaries Design but without the borders, this pattern also includes all the numbers so that you can give a card no matter what year!
Pricking – 15 minutes, Stitching - approx. 1½ hours.

Please note the price of downloads are now A =R22.50, B =R25.00 & C = R27.50



Code B**




**C044 Senior Moments
Code B**




**C045 Birthday Bonnet
